- Heathwood Park also benefits from its close proximity to Haywards Heath, which has excellent rail links to central London (40 minutes) and Brighton (15 minutes). The town centre provides banks, popular shops such as Marks and Spencers, Next, Boots and Currys as well as Sainbury's, Tesco and Co-operative supermarkets. There is also a leisure centre with swimming pools and Haywards Heath and Lindfield golf courses are nearby.
